Minutes

Matters Arising

Results of Ideas Wall

Fred had analysed the results of the ideas posted onto the Ideas Wall at the carnival and produced a report with a pie chart. There were a total of 58 ideas which were grouped into three categories, Sport/recreation, Environmental and Social. The surprise suggestion was call for a swimming pool.

Fred was asked to add a leading paragraph using Lizzie's contact details and submit the report to the Communicata as the group felt it was necessary to show the village some results of their efforts. As the press date was shortly after the meeting Fred will submit the article, send a copy to Lizzie, and hope no changes are required as there isn't time for Group approval.

School Visit

Helen reported that she had been contacted by the school, Ms Collier and Fergusson. They were enthusiastic about the competition and made several suggestions. The school can be split into two groups, Key Stages 1 and 2. There will be a simpler format for the younger KS 1 group.

An A4 sheet will be handed out to all pupils. This is to be divided in two, landscape, and headed "What I like best/worst about Fleckney" for the children to make drawings.

Fred is to help with the Masters for both stages; Helen will show them to the teachers before getting sufficient copies printed, 250 KS2 and 200 KS1. These will then be handed out when representatives of the group visit the school for assembly on 24th September. The sheets will be handed back a week later. Prizes were mentioned but no decision arrived at as it was thought that using the best example(s) on the questionnaire and a display in the library would be sufficient incentive.
