Remove "Don't Know", "Advice on healthy lifestyles", "Other"

Add "Improvement and protection of watercourses"

Q10 ".....around Fleckney do you value"

Change to specific features, Canal, Farmland, Footpaths, Hedgerows.  
Q11A and 11B Discussion not complete on this topic  
Remove "Preserve old orchards", "Repair dry stone walls"  
Add "Protect historic buildings"
