### **Minutes**

### **Publicity**

Publicity at village events to raise the profile of the plan, and appeal to youth, was discussed. Printed balloons for the carnival had been priced but were considered too expensive. Printed tee-shirts could be a better option.

Gary demonstrated an ideal portable display board for using at events, which was a modified pasting table.

Helen presented several ideas for posters. From these Emma is to produce a digital document which Lizzie will print for the Open Gardens event on June 24.

To engage younger children some ideas were floated, logo competition, picture colouring and instead of balloons, kite flying. From this discussion the idea of a competition for the children at Fleckney School evolved. This could comprise of a drawing or drawings of things liked or disliked about the village, or involve a logo. A letter is to be sent to the school to request that the school could become involved.

### **Parish Plan Core Questions Review**

The review of the core questions continued with completion of the Library, Sport Leisure and Recreation, and Crime and Safety sections

The changes required are:

- 5A "Fleckney" replaces "Named Local Library"  
"Other Local Libraries" replaces "Other please specify at end of section"
- 5B Add "Meeting Rooms" and "Council Services Help Desk"
- 5C Jan Leigh to determine if Mobile Library services relevant to Fleckney
- 6D Add "Horse Riding"
- 7C Expand "Public Order" to include "(ASB, Drunk & Disorderly)  
It was expected that Fly Tipping, Dog Mess and Litter would be covered in another section

7G Add also "There is a monthly police surgery held at Fleckney Library.  
Would you make use of it? Yes/No"

**Any Other Business**

A folder is to be created at the Library to hold hard copies of approved meeting minutes

Roy described the provision of web space where the group's documents can be stored and retrieved with access restricted to group members
